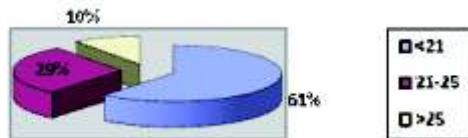
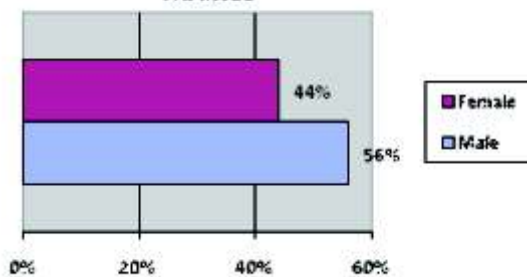

AGE PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED



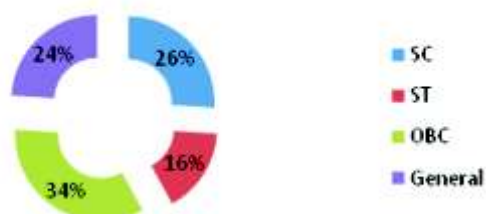
GENDER PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED
